

First Seminar of the Taiwan College of Orthomolecular Medicine



Dr. Hui-Hsiung Liu founded the Taiwan College of Orthomolecular Medicine (TCOM) in 2016. The TCOM is committed to the advocacy for and education of healthcare professionals in orthomolecular medicine. Dr. Liu, the president of TCOM, has been a member of the International Society for Orthomolecular Medicine (ISOM) since 2011 and has applied orthomolecular medicine in his daily practice since then to the benefit of many patients.

In partnership with ISOM, TCOM hosted their first International Orthomolecular Medicine Seminar on November 20th, 2016 in Taipei City. The theme of the seminar was “Next Generation Nutritional Therapy in Health & Disease.” Many

distinguished speakers presented at the seminar, including: Dr. Atsuo Yanagisawa (ISOM President); Dr. Thomas E. Levy; Dr. Penny Kendall-Reed; Dr. Tsuguhito Ota; and Dr. Ming-Shiang Wu. Various issues were discussed during the seminar, including injection therapy in orthomolecular medicine, nutraceutical solutions to neuroendocrine dysfunction, liposome-encapsulated vitamin C, astaxathin, prebiotics and probiotics in clinical applications.
